Common CPT Codes

Insurance companies have different policies, and may cover some tests, but not others. Sometimes, certain requirements must be met before genetic counseling and/or genetic testing can be covered. Like most healthcare provider appointments and tests, you may need to pay for some of the costs.

You can check with your insurance company to verify coverage. In order to do this, you need to provide the procedure codes (CPT codes) for the test(s). For some tests it is recommended that you contact the lab that performs the test for more information about insurance coverage and estimated out of pocket cost. Below is a list of CPT codes for commonly performed genetic tests. Additional testing may be discussed or recommended during your visit.

Your insurance company may not be able to verify coverage without diagnosis codes (ICD-10 codes), or the reason(s) for doing the test(s). ICD-10 codes are determined during your visit.
